**1. The Call. v 43**

- Philip's call to follow Jesus was simple, "follow me"
- Philip's call to follow Jesus answered no questions about the future, other than offering complete satisfaction in Christ, he is all Philip wanted.
- Philip follows the call because of the goodness of Jesus.

**2. Results of Following the Call. v 45-49**

- Jesus is so good; Philip has to tell his friend.
- Nathanael was skeptical, but Philip pushed him to "come and see"
- Nathanael believes because Jesus reveals just enough of himself for Nathanael to believe.
- Neither man followed Jesus because they were good men, but they followed Jesus because Jesus is good!

**3. Following the call today. v 45-49**

- Our call to follow Jesus is simple, "follow me"
- Our call to follow Jesus answers no questions about the future, other than offering complete satisfaction in Christ, he is all we will want.
- When we see Jesus as clearly as Philip did, we will also run to those we love, sharing this good news of Jesus Christ.
- Our family and friends may be skeptical of this Jesus, but we must offer them to "come and see" The mission of Jesus lived out through his body of believers here on this earth. They must see him reflected through all aspects of our lives. If we have been changed by Jesus, this will be impossible to hold back.
