They prayed for the men, and off they went to share the gifts God gave them.

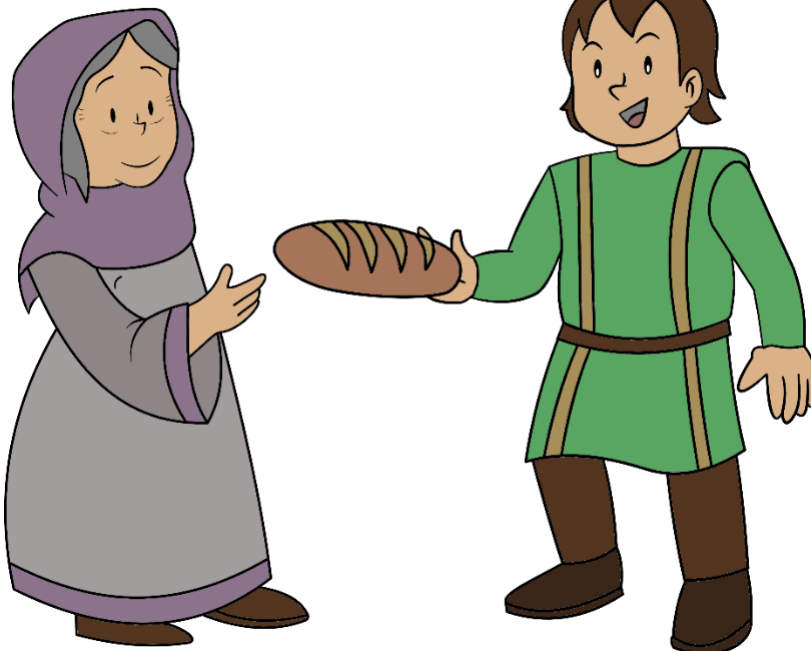
Pray for the toddler.

Babies and Toddlers

Make a sensory bag for your baby or toddler to explore.

Supplies:

Plastic zip bag
Crunched crackers or biscuits
Tape
Scissors
Story images (below)



Instructions:

*Fill a plastic zip bag 1/3 full of crunched crackers or biscuits *Cut out story images and place in the bag *Zip and seal with tape *Put tape on every side to prevent leaks *Retell the story while your baby or toddler explores the bag.

Ask them and help them find and answers:

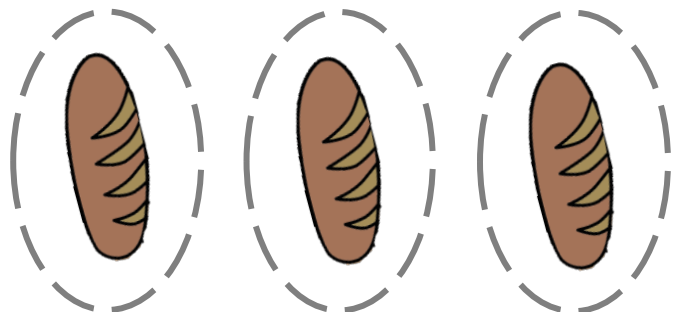
What can you find in the crackers?
