Meander Line; Thence along said Meander Line: N 74° W 20.00 Chs.; N 65° W 6.00 Chs.; N 89° W 22.00 Chs.; N 37° W 10.00 Chs.; N 50° E 10.00 Chs.; N 25° E 11.00 Chs.; N 15° W 16.90 Chs.; S 69° E 8.63 Chs. to intersection with the $\frac{1}{4}$ Section line N. and S. in Section 21; Thence South 13.22 Chs. to intersection with the E. and W. Line between Sections 21 and 28; Thence East 19.92 Chs. to the quarter-section line N. and S. in Section 28; Thence South 20.00 Chs.; Thence East 20.00 Chs. to a Post and Mound set at intersection with the East boundary of Section 28; Thence South 20.00 Chs. to the point of beginning.
Run by the true Meridian: Magnetic Variation $15^{\circ} 45'$ East.
