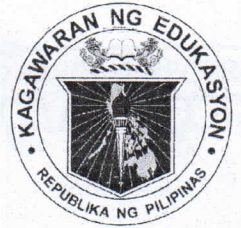

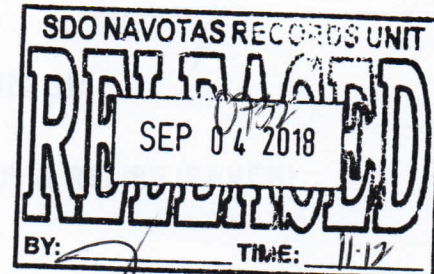

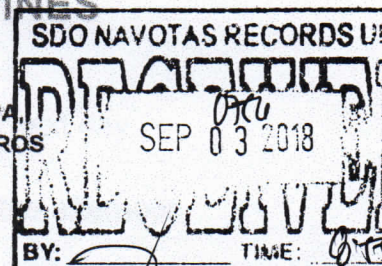

Eating and drinking utensils


