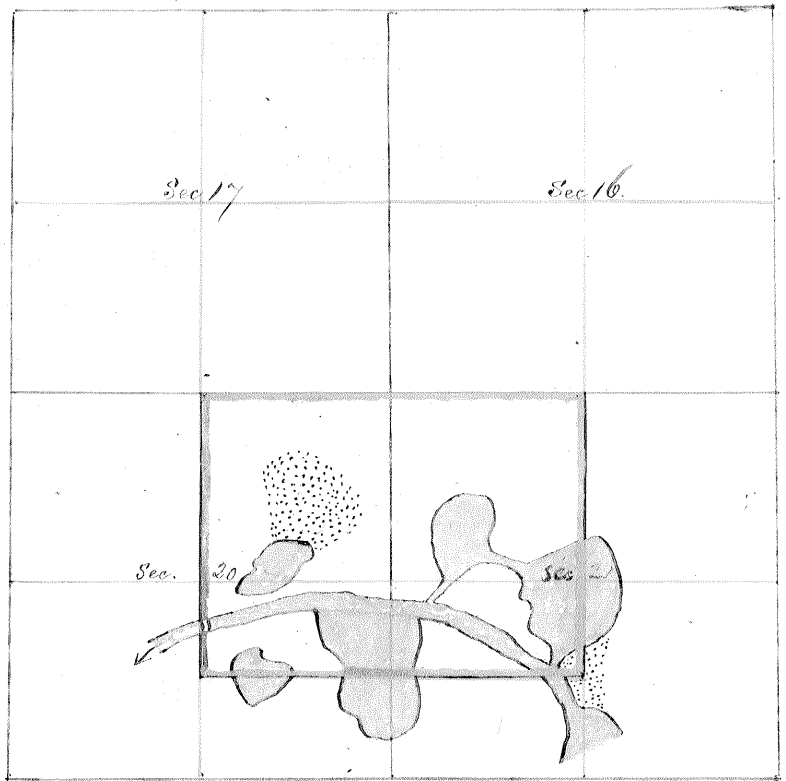

between sections 17 and 20, Township 3 South, Range 7 East, of Mount
Diablo Base and Meridian, as per U.S. surveys; Thence East
80.00 Chains to the quarter section corner on the East and West line
between sections 16 and 21; Thence South 60.00 Chains to the
intersection of the East and West line between the North $\frac{1}{2}$ and the
South half of the South half of section 21; Thence West 80.00
Chains to a Post and mound at intersection with the quarter
section line North and South in section 20; Thence North 60.00
Chains to the point of beginning;

Run by the true Meridian; Magnetic Variation
15° 45' East.
